A.P.A. Hole in One Pool

The hole in one pool is awarded to the first player who records a hole in one at an A.P.A. event. The recipient must be an associate of the Section and in good standing. The Hole-In-One pool is ongoing until a HIO is recorded and not capped at any amount and can rollover for multiple seasons. If there are two HIO during a single day event, those individuals will split the pool. In a multi-day event, if the HIO does not occur in the same round, the first to get the HIO will receive the payout and the pool will officially be restarted.
