



The Junior Development Tour Player Clinics are rconducted at no cost to the junior and are designed to introduce players to competitive and semi-competitive golf in a fun and relaxed environment. Each clinic the juniors receive on course instruction, a tour of the facility, etiquette training, swing tips from PGA Professionals, and a complimentary lunch after the clinic. JDT Clinics are presented by Friends of Golf (FOG) and are open to anyone aged 5-17.








The Players Tour is the flagship level of our program. It is designed to serve juniors of a wide range of playing ability, from juniors who have advanced through the Junior Development Tour, to those looking to earn an invite into the Toyota Tour Cup Series. Players will strive to improve

their game while gaining competitive experience. Playing opportunities are available throughout Southern California at a variety of golf courses. Juniors compete within their age divisions and earn points for the Player of the Year standings. Members have the opportunity to establish an official Handicap Index through the SCGA as a benefit of membership. The Players Tour offers almost 200 opportunities to play competitive golf in a fun atmosphere. Playing competitive golf regularly allows junior golfers to sharpen skills in all facets of the game.








The Toyota Tour Cup Series features the finest Junior Golfers in Southern California hosted by some of the premiere golf courses in the area. Membership for the Toyota Tour Cup is invitation only, which can be attained by qualifying tournaments, Players Tour Series Points or local qualifiers. In addition, the top players from the

following junior golf organizations will be individually invited: Santa Barbara, San Diego, Ventura County, North County, and Valley Junior Golf. All Toyota Tour Cup events are nationally ranked by Junior Golf Scoreboard as well as recognized by AJGA Performance Based Entry stars. Five of the events will be ranked by GolfWeek, including the Toyota Tour Cup Championship. The Boys Division (12-18) will compete from tees at 6,600-7,100+ yards and the Girls Division (12-18) will play from the tees measuring 5,700-6,200+ yards.







### HIGH SCHOOL GOLF COACHES SUMMIT AT URBAN GOLF PERFORMANCE

The 4<sup>th</sup> High School Coaches Summit featured coaches from throughout the California Interscholastic Federation. The featured presenters were Leo Rooney (Urban Golf Performance), Jennifer Bermingham (Coto de Caza Golf & Racquet Club), and Vinnie Bertagna (Los Serranos Country Club). The outstanding list of presenters covered instruction techniques on *Coaching Your Junior Golfer, Teaching the True Beginner*, and the importance of *Golf Fitness Training*.







### QUALIFYING SEASON CANCELED, 2020 NATIONAL FINALS RESCHEDULED

On March 13, it was announced that the 2020 Drive, Chip and Putt National Finals had been postponed due to the impact of the Coronavirus COVID-19. After thoughtful deliberation, and with the guidance of public health experts, the Founding Partners have provided the following update:

1. The 2020-21 Drive, Chip and Putt qualifying season, which was set to begin on May 2, was canceled, given the continued effect of COVID-19 on scheduling during the time period critical to the success of local qualifying. Ultimately, the Founding Partners determined cancellation was the most responsible measure to take in protecting the health of everyone involved in this national endeavor, which includes tens of thousands of participants, their families and all those essential to staging hundreds of qualifying events across all 50 states.

2. The 2020-21 Drive, Chip and Putt National Finals originally scheduled for April 5, 2020, will be rescheduled for April 4, 2021, the eve of the Masters Tournament. Each National Finalist will be invited to compete at Augusta National Golf Club in the same age division for which he or she previously qualified in 2020, regardless of their age on that date.



Summary: PGA Jr. League was positioned for a record-breaking year with player registration up 38% year-over-year when Covid-19 caused a three-month postponement to the season. In response to the global pandemic, PGA Jr. League: Led the development of healthy and responsible back-to-golf guidelines. Was one of the first national sports leagues to return. Had no reported or known Covid-19 cases as a result of Jr. League activities. Created opportunities for nearly 37,000 kids to be outdoors, active, and socially connected while physically distanced. Created exceptional experiences that led to industry-leading and record-breaking <u>net promoter scores</u> amongst both PGA Professionals and parents.



**Project Play**: PGA Jr. League was recognized as a 2020 <u>Project Play Champion</u> for "organizations that are taking new, meaningful, and specific actions consistent with the <u>Project Play framework</u>."

Looking into 2021, we have made some enhancements and updates to the program that will create more local league flexibility for golf professionals to design programs that fit their needs. We have also made adjustments to our postseason events to align with the American Development Model. We are looking forward to a successful 2021 season!

The Southern California PGA Foundation set out to establish a program to assist high school boys and girls in need of their very own set of golf equipment. The unique aspect of the program is that each set is donated to the individual girl/boy, and not the school. This affords the girl/boy the opportunity to continue playing the game on the weekends and pre/post season. Our research found that roughly 70% of high school golfers are competing with "secondhand/borderline serviceable" equipment and 44% borrow or share equipment for practices and matches. We firmly believe this program will continue to grow the game of golf and significantly impact those in-need. Currently, two recipients are playing college golf!
